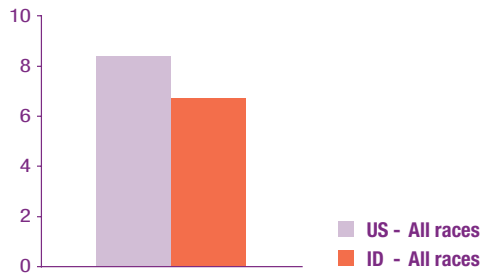

## Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 6.7/100,000 for a score of 2.
- This is lower than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 6.9/100,000 for a score of 2.*
- The mortality rate was 2.7/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 2.8/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- Incidence and mortality rates are not available by race.

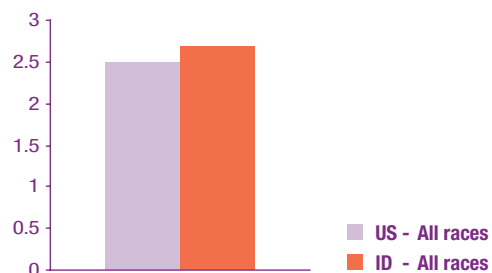
## Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and ID (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

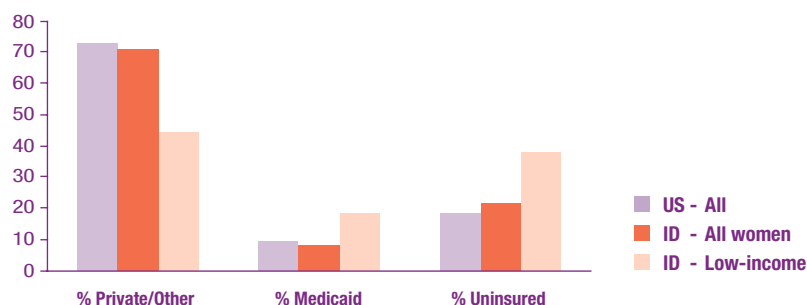


## Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 78.8% for a score of 0.
- This is lower than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 78.4% for a score of 0.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 21% of women are uninsured for a score of 0.
- This is higher than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 20% for a score of 1.*

## Policy Initiatives and Infrastructure

- **Coverage mandates for cervical cancer screening**
  - There are no new coverage or screening mandates for a cumulative score of 1.
- **Task force/commissions for cervical cancer prevention**
  - SCR 110, introduced February 14, 2005, authorizes the Legislative Council to appoint a Cervical Cancer Elimination Committee, and to take the lead in reviewing data regarding cervical cancer and human papillomavirus in women in the state of Idaho. Cumulative score of 1.
- **Miscellaneous support of cervical cancer prevention**
  - There is no miscellaneous cervical cancer prevention legislation for a cumulative score of 0.
