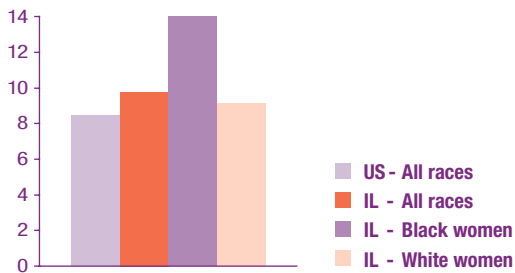
State population estimate: 12,713,634

Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 9.7/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate for last year's report was 11.1/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- The mortality rate was 3.1/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate for last year's report was 2.8/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- Incidence and mortality rates were higher among black women than white women.

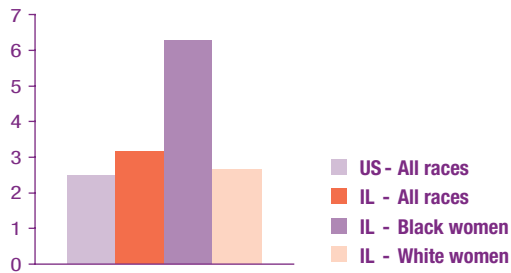
Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and IL (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

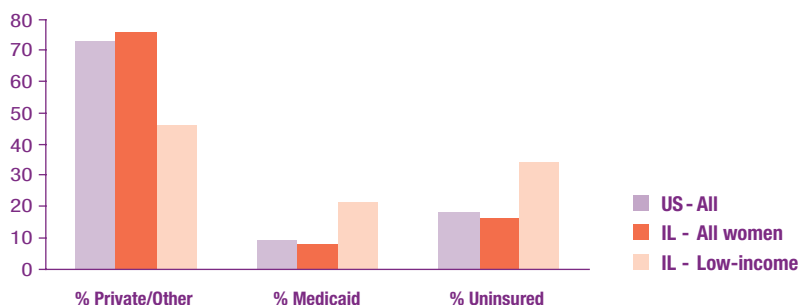


Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 87.4% for a score of 2.
- This is higher than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate for last year's report was 81.8% for a score of 1.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 16% of women are uninsured for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured for last year's report was 16% for a score of 1.*

Policy Initiatives and Infrastructure

- **Coverage mandates for cervical cancer screening**
 - There are no new coverage or screening mandates for a cumulative score of 1.
- **Task force/commissions for cervical cancer prevention**
 - There is no new task force or commission for a cumulative score of 2.
- **Miscellaneous support of cervical cancer prevention**
 - HB 3564, introduced February 24, 2005, provides that the Department of Public Health shall appropriate funds from the Penny Severns Breast, Cervical and Ovarian Cancer Research Fund for breast, cervical and ovarian cancer research. Amends the State Finance Act. Changes the name of the Penny Severns Breast and Cervical Cancer Research Fund to the Penny Severns Breast, Cervical and Ovarian Cancer Research Fund. Deletes a Section creating the Cervical, Breast and Ovarian Cancer Elimination Task Force. Provides for disbursement of funds. Cumulative score of 2.
