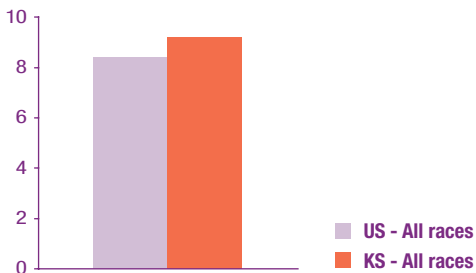
State population estimate: 2,735,502

## Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 9.2/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 9.1/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- The mortality rate was 2.4/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 2.8/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- Incidence and mortality rates are not available by race.

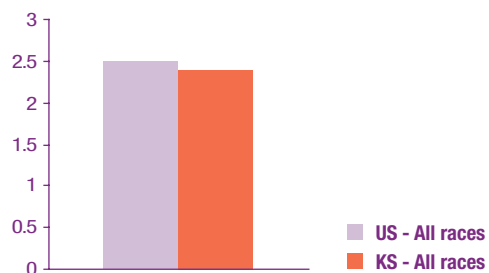
## Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and KS (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

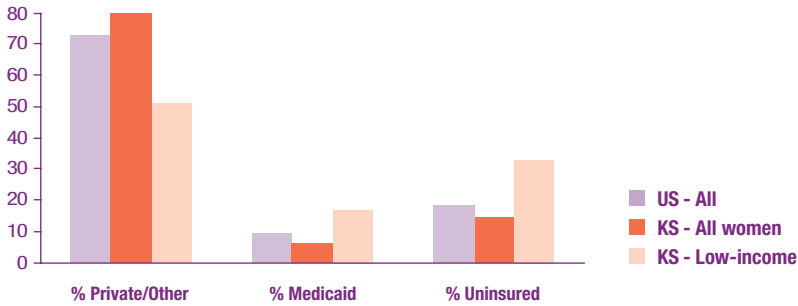


## Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 86.1% for a score of 2.
- This is higher than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 84.2% for a score of 1.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 14% of women are uninsured for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 15% for a score of 1.*

## Policy Initiatives and Infrastructure

- **Coverage mandates for cervical cancer screening**
  - There are no new coverage or screening mandates, for a cumulative score of 1.
- **Task force/commissions for cervical cancer prevention**
  - There is no task force or commission for a cumulative score of 1.
- **Miscellaneous support of cervical cancer prevention**
  - HR 6021, introduced March 9, 2005, urges the Secretary of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment to review the data regarding cervical cancer and human papillomavirus, to evaluate current methods of public education and access to regular cervical cancer screening and to consider options for increasing screening accuracy. Cumulative score of 1.
