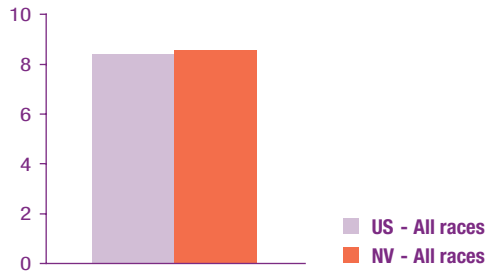

Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 8.6/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 12.4/100,000 for a score of 0.*
- The mortality rate was 2.7/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 3.0/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- Incidence and mortality rates are not available by race.

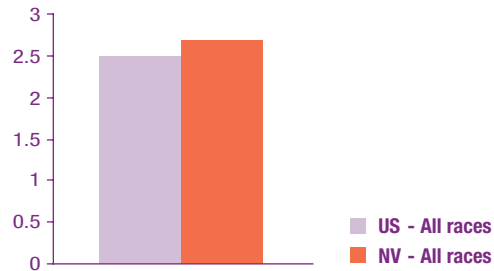
Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and NV (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

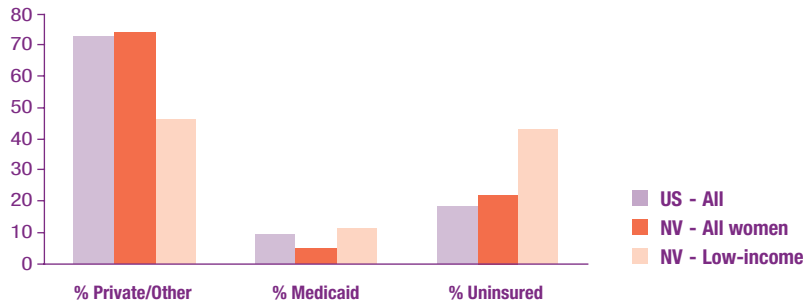


Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 84.7% for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 80.3% for a score of 0.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 22% of women are uninsured for a score of 0.
- This is higher than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 18% for a score of 1.*

Policy Initiatives and Infrastructure

- **Coverage mandates for cervical cancer screening**
 - There are no new coverage or screening mandates for a cumulative score of 1.
- **Task force/commissions for cervical cancer prevention**
 - AB 212, introduced March 16, 2005, creates the Task Force for Elimination of Cervical Cancer.
 - SB 98, introduced February 21, 2005, creates the Task Force on Cervical Cancer and provides its duties; revises the provisions relating to per diem allowances and travel expenses for members of the Task Force on Prostate Cancer; makes an appropriation.
 - Cumulative score of 2.
- **Miscellaneous support of cervical cancer prevention**
 - There is no miscellaneous cervical cancer prevention legislation for a cumulative score of 0.
