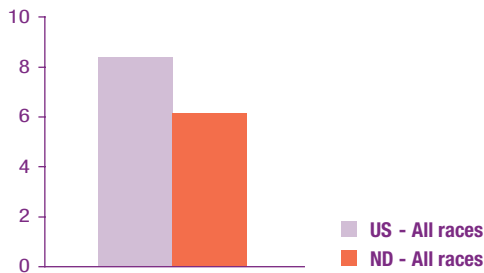

Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 6.2/100,000 for a score of 2.
- This is lower than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 5.5/100,000 for a score of 2.*
- The mortality rate was 2.2/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 2.6/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- Incidence and mortality rates are not available by race

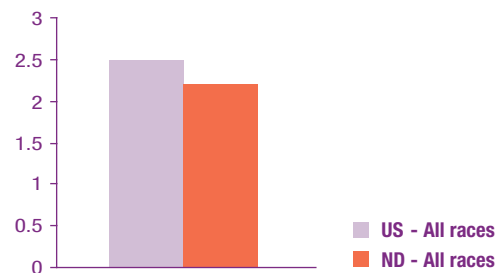
Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and ND (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

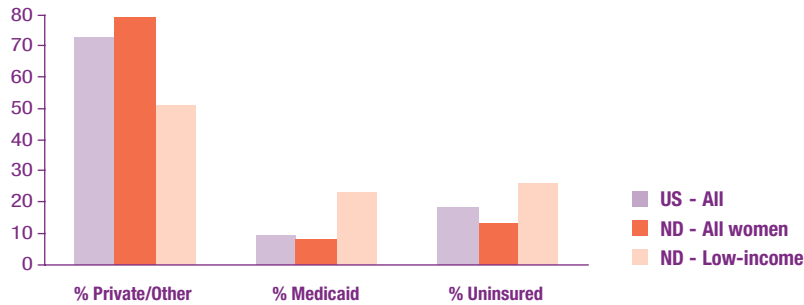


Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 83.2% for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 82.1% for a score of 1.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 13% of women are uninsured for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 12% for a score of 1.*

Policy Initiatives and Infrastructure

- **Coverage mandates for cervical cancer screening**
 - There are no coverage or screening mandates for a cumulative score of 0.
- **Task force/commissions for cervical cancer prevention**
 - There is no task force or commission for a cumulative score of 0.
- **Miscellaneous support of cervical cancer prevention**
 - HCR 3022, introduced January 27, 2005, directs the Legislative Council to study data regarding cervical cancer and human papillomavirus; evaluates current methods of public education and access to regular cervical cancer screening; considers options for increasing screening accuracy. Cumulative score of 2.
