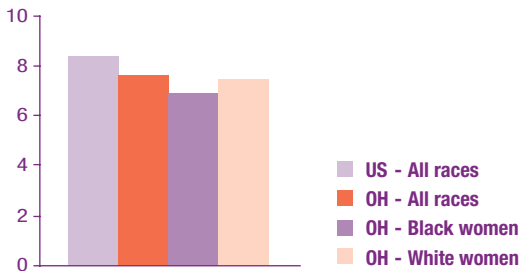
State population estimate: 11,459,011

Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 7.6/100,000 for a score of 2.
- This is lower than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 8.6/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- The mortality rate was 2.9/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 2.5/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- The incidence rate was higher for white women than black women; the mortality rate was higher among black women than among white women.

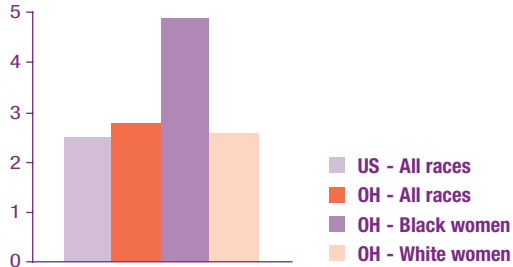
Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and OH (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

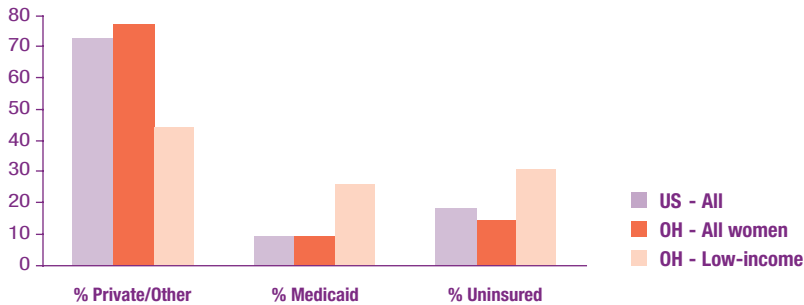


Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 86.4% for a score of 2.
- This is higher than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 84.5% for a score of 1.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 14% of women are uninsured for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 14% for a score of 1.*

Policy Initiatives and Infrastructure

- Coverage mandates for cervical cancer screening

- HB 78, introduced February 3, 2005, requires health care policies, plans, and agreements to extend coverage to newer forms of screening for cervical cancer detection. Cumulative score of 1.

- Task force/commissions for cervical cancer prevention

- There is no task force or commission for a cumulative score of 0.

- Miscellaneous support of cervical cancer prevention

- There is no miscellaneous cervical cancer prevention legislation for a cumulative score of 0.
