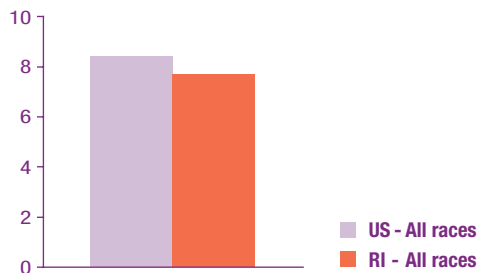
State population estimate: 1,080,632

Incidence and Mortality

- The incidence rate was 7.7/100,000 for a score of 2.
- This is lower than the national average of 8.4/100,000.
- *The incidence rate in last year's report was 8.2/100,000 for a score of 2.*
- The mortality rate was 2.9/100,000 for a score of 1.
- This is higher than the national average of 2.5/100,000.
- *The mortality rate in last year's report was 2.1/100,000 for a score of 1.*
- Incidence and mortality rates are not available by race.

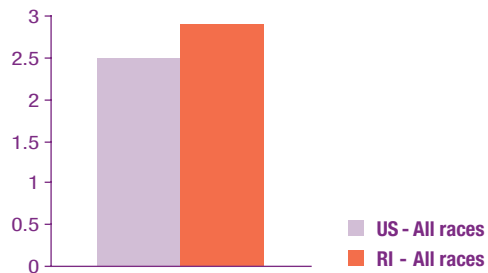
Cervical Cancer Incidence

US and RI (# of deaths per 100,000 women)

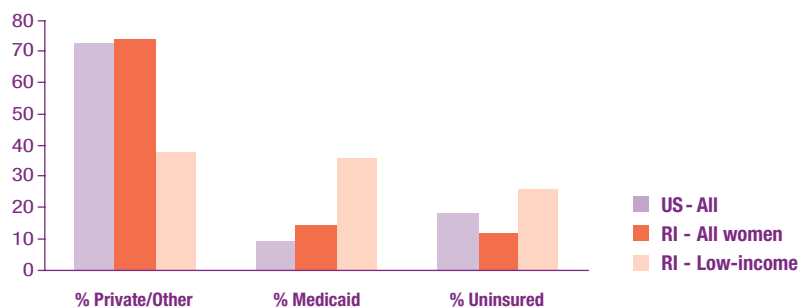


Healthcare Access and Utilization

- The cervical cancer screening rate was 88.9% for a score of 2.
- This is higher than the national average of 85.9%.
- *The screening rate in last year's report was 86.5% for a score of 2.*
- In this state, Medicaid offers unrestricted coverage of HPV testing, for a score of 2.
- In this state, 12% of women are uninsured for a score of 1.
- This is lower than the national average of 18%.
- *The rate of uninsured in last year's report was 11% for a score of 1.*
