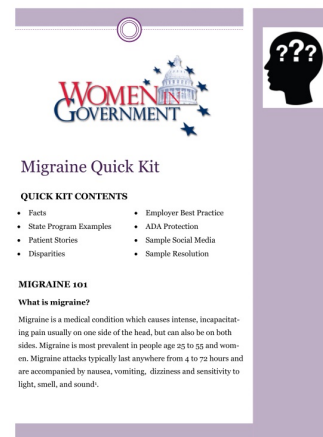

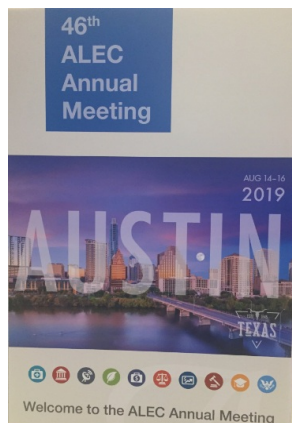


## Wake Up With WIG Breakfast at NCSL in Nashville, Tennessee!
