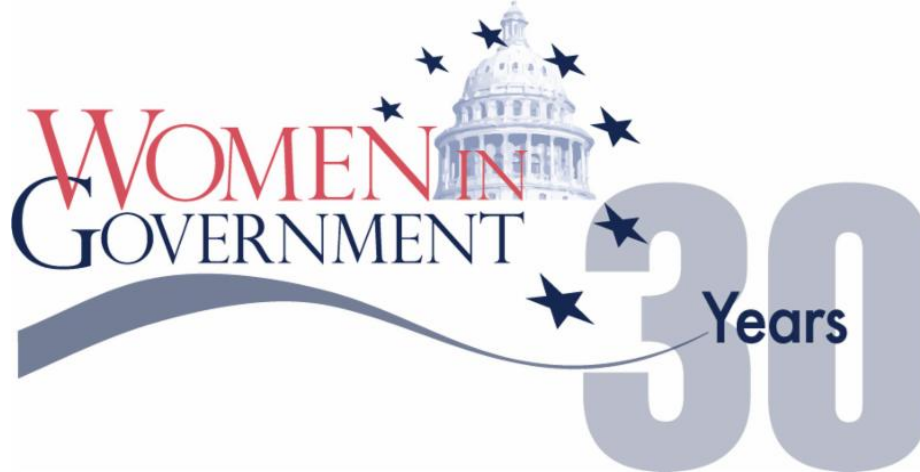

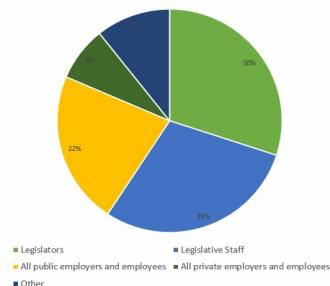
The Pulse Poll Results Are In!
